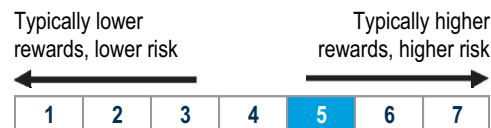

Commentary and Outlook

Gross of fees, the fund delivered a positive return in sterling terms over the fourth quarter, outperforming the benchmark.

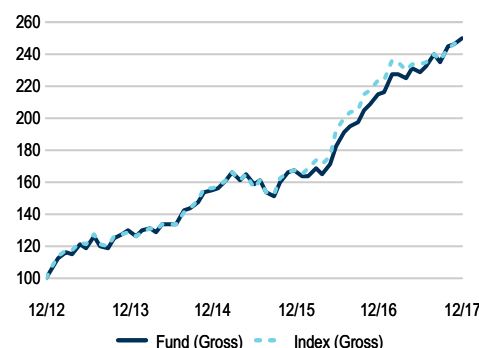
Stock selection and sector allocation both had a positive impact over the quarter. Our stock picks in industrials did most to boost returns, with Caterpillar a notable outperformer. The industrial-equipment maker reported strong results in all sectors and regions in the third quarter, and is enjoying a further boost from the strengthening world economy. Our selections in healthcare and consumer discretionary also contributed strongly over the period, while top individual contributors included Bank of America, Microsoft and graphics technology business NVIDIA.

In terms of allocation, our overweight to technology was most beneficial as the sector enjoyed another strong quarter. Our underweight to telecoms also added value.

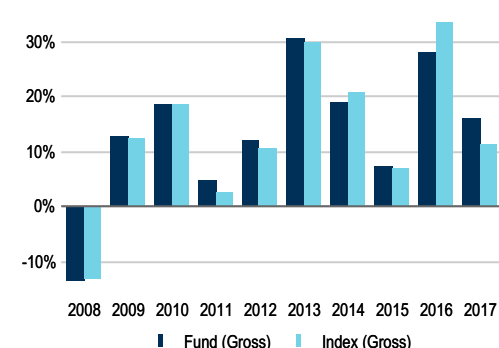
Fund Objective & Policy
